#### Burglary Habitation:

16700 Champion Forest Drive - Marcos Pizza - Complainant reported known relative who was also an employee possibly stole \$1,400.00 cash left overnight. No charges filed at this time. Occurred during morning hours.

**Disturbance Family :**

**Other Calls:**

7900 Annola Lane - Complainant requested documentation in reference to non-custodial parent taking child. Occurred overnight.

7300 Louetta Road - Complainant reported suspect made impact with multiple vehicles and fled the scene without providing information. Suspect was later apprehended and charges were filed. Occurred during morning hours.

8100 Cypresswood Drive - The Lodge at Cypresswood Apartments - Complainant reported unknown suspects opened a Verizon account without her consent. Occurred during evening hours.

16400 Kleinwood Drive - Complainant reported spit cups were thrown on his yard. Occurred overnight.

7300 Louetta Road - Starbucks - Complainant reported unknown suspect struck vehicle and fled without exchanging information. Occurred during morning hours.

7800 Louetta Road - Unik Cleaners - Complainant requested documentation in reference to lost documents. Occurred during evening hours.

(2) JUVENILE DIST. – Contract patrol deputies responded to juvenile type of disturbance. Parents were notified and all calls were handled without incident while gathering intelligence for the community to remain safe.

(3) DISTURBANCE OTHER - Contract patrol deputies responded to disturbances involving adults, within the community. All calls were handled without incident and dispersed accordingly while gathering intelligence for the safety of the contract.

(13) ALARMS - Contract patrol deputies responded to local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

(10) SUSPICIOUS PERSON – Contract Patrol deputies responded to suspicious persons within the community gathering intelligence while identifying potential problems. All persons were cleared without incident.

(6) SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES – Contract patrol deputies responded to twelve suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.

(6) MUD CHECKS - Contract patrol deputies made six Municipal Utility Checks within the community. There were no signs of foul play and all facilities appeared to be in good working order.

(0) TRAFFIC - Contract patrol deputies conducted traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.

(15) ACCIDENTS – Units responded to seventeen minor, major, and FSGL accidents in the patrol area clearing the roadway and charging the individuals at fault in the wrecks. Safety was restored and traffic was brought back to a normal pace.

(13) NEIGHBORHOOD CHECKS – Contract patrol units conducted neighborhood checks while maintaining the peace in the communities and enhancing visibility. All checks were made without incident.

(35) BUSINESS and PARKING LOT CHECKS – Contract and District units conducted business and parking lot checks within the MUD enhancing visibility in areas that would have potential problems with criminal activity.

(0) PARK CHECKS - Contract patrol units conducted ten park checks ensuring that there was no criminal activity and maintaining a visual on citizens of the community. All checks were made without incident.
